FINANCE AND THE REAL ECONOMY

The Summer School is a week-long intensive seminar designed to bring together a pool of international lecturers and graduate students to discuss key issues in financial history. This year the focus will be on the interaction of financial and economic activities, the evolution of credit markets and the contribution of credit organisations to economic growth. Lecturers will present case studies from a wide range of historical perspectives and geographical backgrounds discussing episodes of successful development as well as episodes of poor allocation and misuse of resources. The Seminar is open to 15 graduate students with a strong background in economics and history (application deadline **16 June 2006**). Pre-session materials and reading suggestions will be made available online to participants in the program.
